EVENT

In case of a tiebreaker poets will be required to do another reading...

RULES

Each poem must be of the poet's own construction;

Each poet gets three minutes (plus a ten-second grace period) to read one poem, if the poet goes over, points will be deducted from the total score

The poet may not use props, costumes, or musical instruments

Of the scores the poet received from the 5 judges, the high and low scores are dropped, and the middle three are added together, giving the poet a total score of 0-30.
